Tarot Card Reading Report

Spread used: the Celtic Cross Spread

Question: *What does Mike need to know about his job at this time?*

the Cards Drawn:

1. the Present Situation: **3 of Swords**

This card suggests a period of pain, hurt, and loss. When it appears in work-related readings, it can suggest severance. In this case, it can mean people are leaving the workplace. This can come in the form of people being fired or laid off. Cutbacks of some kind are having to be made.

2. the Cross: **Strength**

This card is about having the courage and confidence to overcome obstacles. If things like firings and lay-offs are taking place, this card suggests needing to be confident in your skills and abilities enough to know that you will survive this period.

This card combination suggests a health challenge may be important at this time. This may be something that may affect your working situation in some way. If

this is the case, Strength is a healing card, but it insists that patience, self-control, and self-restraint are important.

3. the Root: **5 of Swords**

This card is about the parting of ways. This card reinforces that people are leaving the workplace, some being terminated. As a result, some of these employees may seek legal action against your employer. You may have been concerned about your own place in this environment, and whether you should leave yourself.

This card can suggest being in a struggle, getting little help or compassion from others. Business associates may be attacking one another.

4. the Recent Past: **6 of Swords**

This card is about seeking a change for the better. It is about escaping a difficult situation. In a working situation, this card can suggest leaving a well-known aspect of your job for something new and different. You are seeking ways to lessen the stress and strain of the job. You may be moving into the unknown in regard to work. Again, this card can suggest that you have thought about leaving your workplace in the past, possibly without being certain where you would be going next.

5. the Crown: **5 of Cups**

This card is about disappointment. It's about having expectations unrealized. This card can suggest that high expectations are placed on others, and they can't meet the standards they are faced with.

Another aspect of this card is dealing with some form of regret or remorse after some loss. This could be a regret for having let certain individuals leave the workplace. These individuals' loss may be seriously felt.

This card can suggest the possibility of continued downsizing or reorganization. In regard to health, you may be feeling tired and burned-out.

6. the Near Future: **9 of Cups**

This card is known as "the wish card." In this position, it can mean that a hope or wish you have had regarding this situation is going to be fulfilled. This card promises some form of satisfaction and contentment.

A chance meeting or a contact can bring unexpected good fortune.

7. the Self: **3 of Pentacles**

This is one of the "work" cards in the deck. This particular card is about achievement, recognition, and success. In this position, it suggests you being a

"master" at what it is you do. This card can also indicate that people are watching you. You may also be seeking a raise or promotion at work.

With the *5 of Cups* as your crowning card, you could possibly be disappointed as a result of being overlooked for said promotion.

8. the Environment: **9 of Wands**

This card warns of needing to be "on guard" in your working environment. There may be a need to keep your own counsel regarding a matter.

This card can suggest one challenge after another in your working environment, but you continually manage to survive.

Lastly, this card can suggest that a person or people on the job can cause you "headaches."

9. Guidance/Advice: **10 of Pentacles**

This card, in relation to work, can indicate working for a family-owned business, or a large company or corporation. It can be a place that is multi-level, which allows for advancement, and one that has people of all ages in it.

In the position of advice or guidance, it can mean that you have been considering self-employment. If you have, now may be the time to strongly pursue this endeavor.

10. the Outcome: **the Empress**

This card, as your outcome, suggests a period of productivity. A project of some kind, that has been in its developmental stages, may pay off in a big way. This card says you will achieve the "fruits of your labor."

In regard to health, this card can mean a need to take care of oneself.

Speaking of labor, there are a couple of cards (*3 of Pentacles, the Empress*) that suggest a pregnancy. You may receive news that someone is expecting.

In your reading, the ruling suit is **Swords**. This suggests that there are conflicts, problems, and troubles connected to work. Work may be a place filled with struggles and animosity. The environment can be one that causes stress, worry, and anxiety. You may need to be making some major decisions regarding this area of your life.

In your reading, the most repeated number is **3**, which is a number connected to career, which makes sense, considering this is what your question pertains to.

The other repeating numbers are **5** and **9**. Five is the number of instability and flux; it suggests things are changing on the job. Nine is the number of completion, which means that there are things about the job/workplace that are coming to an end. The nine suggests the possibility of a new path.
